BIG DADDY COOL

In the week from June 29 to July 5 there were 10 litters registered with GRV.

WEST SUNSHINE breeder, Steven Meilak registered a litter of two dogs and two bitches whelped March 6 by Big Daddy Cool (Just The Best x Sobbing Sal) from Ballistic Iowa.

The dam, a daughter of Kiowa Sweet Trey and Ballistic Rose, scored twice in 32 runs and they were over 430 metres at Bendigo where her PB was 24.46.

The successful members of her litter were Ballistic Dancer (2 wins), Barefoot Radler (3 wins) and Kiowa Diamond (6 wins).

The dam comes from a very good damline, telling us these youngsters should have their share of ability.

Droopys Kewell

IRISH stud dog, Droopys Kewell (Larkhill Jo x Perrys Pusher) sired a litter of four dogs and four bitches from Little Spiral.

These youngsters, whelped February 28 were registered by Devon Meadows breeder, John Downer.

Little Spiral, a daughter of Spiral Nikita and Ravada Reason, raced 24 times for one win and that was at Bendigo over 700 metres in 40.75.

Her successful littermates were Ashen Chaos (2 wins), Rhoda Reason (12 wins), Roxette Reason (5 wins) and Two Up Amy (2 wins).

This pairing brings together two of the world's greatest sires and that augurs very well for the future prospects of these youngsters.

Bit Chili

National Sprint champion, Bit Chili (Bombastic Shiraz x Chili Berger) sired a litter of one dog and one bitch from St. Cassbe, whelped February 18 and registered by Springvale South breeder, Gavin Ithier.



Bit Chili, winner of the 2007 National Sprint title, is fast becoming a sire of choice for many breeders.

St. Cassbe, a daughter of Where's Pedro and Awesome Saint, raced once without scoring.

And St Cassbe was the only member of her litter.

The dam comes from a very successful damline, suggesting that these two youngsters should pick up their fair share of wins.

Pure Octane

GAVIN KEARNS, Manager of the Kearns And Ayres Syndicate, registered a litter of three dogs and three bitches by National Sprint champ, Pure Octane (Token Prince x Elusive Rebel) from Deep Yellow, whelped March 20.

Deep Yellow, a daughter of Whisky Assassin and Many Tricks, had 21 starts for two wins, scoring at Richmond over 535 metres in 30.87, as well as scoring at Wangaratta over 474 metres in 27.38.

In her litter were Glen Abbey Boss (2 wins), Glen Abbey Lass (3 wins), Glen Abbey Sam (2 wins), Glen Abbey Trish (3 wins), Old West (2 wins) and Sherlock Bob (12 wins).

When the dam's mother was paired to the sire's father it produced Malfoy, and based on that, these youngsters should have a bright future.

Jim Joes Up

IRISH stud dog, Jim Joes Up (Larkhill Jo x Quare Reward) sired a litter of one dog and five bitches whelped March 14 from Golden Womby, registered by Edenhope breeder, Cap Abbott.

Golden Womby, a daughter of Placard and Sunbeam Honcho, scored in 12 of her 60 goes, picking up a win at Shepparton over 440 metres in 25.05, two wins at Bendigo over 430 metres with a PB of 24.63 and a victory at Sandown over 515 metres in 30.45.

She also scored at Horsham over 480 metres in 27.92, as well as picking up seven wins at Angle Park where her best was 29.92.

The other members of her litter were Handycard (8 wins), Jay Jay Jackson (5 wins) and Mi Ling River (1 win).

Golden Womby has had one litter to race and that was to Where's Pedro whelped May 2007, producing Where's Womby (9 wins) and Womby Jet (5 wins).

The dam has already produced two smart chasers and that tells us these youngsters should have plenty of talent too.

El Galo

CHAMPION chaser, El Galo (Where's Pedro x Roxy Reason) sired a litter of three dogs and three bitches from Oh Behave whelped March 11, registered by Pearceedale breeder, Steve Shinnars.

Oh Behave, a daughter of Big Ginger Boy and Hunter Tylo, had 75 starts winning 34 of those, scoring six times over 515 metres at Sandown with a PB of 29.75 and five times there over 715 metres where her best was 42.48.

She picked up three wins at Cranbourne over 520 metres where 30.50 was her best, as well as winning over the 699 metres there in 41.90.

She scored seven wins over the 600 metres at The Meadows with a track record of 34.09 being her fastest and picked up four wins there over 725 metres with 42.71 being her best.

She won four races at Sale over 630 metres with 36.33 being her quickest, she scored twice at Traralgon over 658 metres where the track record time of 38.40 was her PB, saluted over 720 metres at Wentworth Park in 42.57 and at Geelong over 600 metres in 34.60.

The other successful members of her litter were Crossing Over (6 wins), Don't Tempt Fate (6 wins), Elite Action (13 wins), Hey Yeah (4 wins) and Miss Forrester (3 wins).

Oh Behave has had four litters to race so far, with her first to Token Prince whelped November 2004 producing Pacifier (4 wins), Speedos (21 wins), Springvale Snow (15 wins), Superior Inc (7 wins), Triple Oh (7 wins) and Will You Behave (9 wins).

Litter number two was to Big Daddy Cool whelped July 2005 and that gave us Gingerbread Boy (9 wins), Oh So Cool (11 wins), Over The Edge (3 wins), Space Odyssey (6 wins) and Supercilious (6 wins).

Her third litter was to Where's Pedro whelped April 2006 left us with Big Bam (3 wins), Ego (1 win), Invisiting Me (10 wins), Oh Believe (2 wins), Oh Reign (5 wins), Peach Bikini (10 wins), Pedro Behave (2 wins) and Roman Past (4 wins).

Finally, her fourth litter was to Premier Fantasy whelped July 2007 and that produced Oh Cee Ya (3 wins), Oh Gee (1 win) and Sober (1

win). The dam was a champion racer who has already produced plenty of winners and there's no reason why these youngsters won't meet with good success too.

Leefull

A LITTER of four dogs and six bitches sired by Leefull (Brett Lee x Grigorieva) from Gypsy Tokay whelped April 12 was registered by Merbein breeder, Robert Versteeg.

Gypsy Tokay, a daughter of Fortified Speed and Cushti, raced 76 times for 14 wins, notching two wins at Kulpara over 300 metres with her best being 16.72 and five wins at Darwin over 312 metres with a PB of 18.47, as well as seven wins there over 383 metres with her quickest being 22.54.

Her successful littermates were Brit's Best (11 wins), Slap And Tickle (2 wins) and Valiant Jade (1 win).

The dam won plenty of races in the Top End, suggesting these youngsters should have their fair share of ability.

Bombastic Shiraz

TRIPLE CROWN champ, Bombastic Shiraz (Black Shiraz x Bombastic Blonde) sired a litter of four dogs and four bitches whelped March 3 from Pipe Dreams, registered by Bendigo breeder, Ian Garland.

Pipe Dreams, a daughter of Surf Lorian and Rated Perfect, the only member of her litter, scored once in 10 starts and that was over 450 metres at Shepparton in 25.82.

The dam comes from a very successful family and that says these youngsters should win plenty of races.

Where's Pedro

ELLIMINYT breeder, Paul Carmichael registered a litter of two dogs

and three bitches whelped March 16 by Where's Pedro (Brett Lee x Elusive Rebel) from Miss Baracus.

The dam, a daughter of Harvard Bale and Korrina Miss, won four of her 50 outings, scoring at Ballarat over 550 metres in 31.88 and at The Meadows over 600 metres in 35.73.

She saluted over 520 metres at Cranbourne in 31.21, as well as picking up a win at Mt. Gambier over 512 metres in 30.92.

The successful members of her litter were Black Presence (18 wins), Fleet Dreams (5 wins), Outlaw Man (3 wins) and Tyson's Law (12 wins).

Miss Baracus has had one litter to date and that was to Typhoon Tide whelped May 2007, giving us Calm Presence (6 wins), Make Some Noise (8 wins), Small Presence (4 wins) and Typhoon Baracus (2 wins).

The dam has already produced plenty of winners and that puts the future of these youngsters in good stead.
